Divine Attributions

Mercy...there's the ten-dollar word for the week! I remember learning when I was young that God knew everything. He even knew me! A Polish religious woman, St. Faustina Kowalska, who lived in the 20th century, shared with the world her devotion to God's mercy, learned as part of her encounters with Jesus. Following the wishes of Pope John Paul II, this Sunday, the Second Sunday of Easter, in the Octave of Easter, we refer to as "Divine Mercy Sunday".

Mercy is a little understood today. We think it is just avoiding punishment or pain. But mercy is an outpouring of God's loving kindness. It is generous love. Mercy applies to every nook and cranny of our sometimes confusing existence. Mercy not only prevents evil from happening it offers us life.

The reason the Holy Father was inclined to time this feast within the Octave of Easter is that the redeeming love of Christ we celebrate through His resurrection is **THE** act of mercy. It changes not only my personal life but it changes the whole aim of human existence. "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." Mercy is at the heart of the Gospel.
