## \* A Message from the Pastor



### **Conversion of St. Paul**

On Wednesday we celebrated the Conversion of St. Paul. His conversion was dramatic. That may be the biggest thing we remember about it. Reading his letters and following him through the Acts of the Apostles reveals many other things. Here are a few.

- 1. He collaborates. Conversion results not only in his vibrant personality shining through his evangelizing work, but clearly, he enjoys being strongly connected to others who are building up the Christian life. His letters show his care for his communities and his awareness of the personalities found in them.
- 2. He is not weighed down by his past. He has accepted Christ and is able both to see his past and build on the forgiveness he has received. His conversion is deepened so that he can see the greater gift that now outweighs his failings.
- 3. The effect of conversion is that he is able to be flexible, to exert energy and use his gifts in the service of the Good News with differing groups of people. His own basic sense of security helps him to be flexible allowing him to be moving all over the place and adjusting himself to all kinds of situations.

4. The famous passage from the First Letter to the Corinthians on love gives a kind of vision of mature Christian living that combines the heart, the interior, with the practical elements of living. He points to conversion that continues through time. There is an acceptance of the truth of being put at rights with God by Jesus, while learning to reflect that in attitude and behaviour.

St. Paul emphasizes that the Good News is a gift – not something we have merited on our own. We are called to respond to it. His response is to write his letters and preach the Good News.

If there was one letter to read, my own choice would be the First Letter to the Corinthians. It contains a clear message of the Good News and provides solid advice.

May the gentle breath of the Holy Spirit bring to our hearts the Gospel of Peace. May the living Word penetrate our deepest recesses so that we can trust in His promises.
