### **A Message from the Pastor**



#### The Bishop

What is a bishop? A successor of the apostles. A witness to the Good News and to Christ, the Risen Lord, who came to earth, suffered, died and then rose returning to God the Father.

What does a bishop do? The bishop's role is described by three aspects: teaching, sanctifying and providing governance of the Church in a particular place. The first requires prudent judgement about the way of presenting the whole of our faith to help people adopt it more deeply. The second is a call to personal witness in the bishop's own way of life as well as leading the local Church in prayer. This is most obvious at the Mass, the other sacraments and the Prayer of the Church at the cathedral or other parts of the diocese.

How are bishops sent to dioceses? The appointment of bishops is reserved to the Holy Father and he uses his department for bishops, the papal ambassador in any particular country as well, as other sources of advice to determine who he may decide to appoint.

Cardinal Collins has retired as Archbishop of Toronto. What does his retirement mean? It is helpful first to remember the difference between ordination and holding an office in the Catholic Church. Cardinal Collins has retired from the office of being the Archbishop of Toronto. He is still a member of the College of Cardinals and could potentially vote in a future papal election. Currently, he still holds a number of appointments also to departments at the Vatican. He remains a member of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Assembly of the Catholic Bishops of Ontario. Until the new bishop comes he is the administrator of the Archdiocese.

The Holy Father appointed Bishop Francis (Frank) Leo as Archbishop of Toronto on Saturday, February 11, 2023. Is he our bishop right now? The appointment has been made, but Bishop Leo will come to the Archdiocese and present the papal appointment letter. We call this process "taking possession" of

the diocese. Once he has done that, he becomes our Archbishop. There will be a Mass at the Cathedral where the priests, deacons, religious, and a part of the faithful will take part to receive him and see him installed in his "cathedra" his chair which represents the presence of his ministry. We are waiting for a date to be published for this to take place.

Archbishop-Designate Leo – who is he? You may have read about him already on the website of the Archdiocese (archtoronto.org). He is a priest of the Archdiocese of Montreal who has had a wide set of experiences and an impressive education. In Canada, he has most recently served as auxiliary bishop in Montreal and before that served as General Secretary of the national conference of bishops. He is the youngest archbishop we have had since the appointment of Cardinal McGuigan in 1934. He could be our shepherd for 24 years.

In my article two weeks ago, I talked about ways the Church is "big" and "small". When we realize that there are only three levels in the basic structure, the Universal Church, the diocese and the parish, we can appreciate how important it is to work together to build up the Kingdom. Archbishop-Designate Leo will have a lot to absorb and then arrange to help us do that. He will build on the work of Cardinal Collins and he will have insights and priorities of his own. May he be guided by the Holy Spirit.

So, as we give thanks for the prayer, hard work and service of Cardinal Collins and welcome Archbishop-Designate Leo let us call on our patron, St. Paul, to inspire them and us to evangelize and to be receptive humble, and joyfully serve the Gospel in Christ's name.


