❖ A Message from the Pastor



Come Holy Spirit!

At Baptism, at Confirmation and really in all the sacraments, the Holy Spirit breathes on us a fuller life in Christ. We don't, however, usually give much thought to it. We love to say we're "inspired". That usually means we are energized or have a new experience that delights us.

What if we really knew that we could live in God's deep and redeeming love? It would make even the things that we find difficult the fruits of real inspiration. Can I do that difficult but valuable thing with love?

The *Gifts of the Holy Spirit* are really showered on us. We need to be awake to them, and we can be certain that they call us out of ourselves to serve others. Our soul is like a garden that needs to be nurtured. So, when this garden is well tended it shares its beauty with anyone who looks at it and feeds those who recognize its fruits. In other words, we deepen our spiritual life not for ourselves but so that we can be responsive to Christ alive in us and the family of Christ may grow.

Our candidates will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on June 29th, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, one of two feasts of St. Paul that are near and dear to our parish. Bishop Robert Kasun will be here to celebrate the sacrament. In the Sacrament of Holy Orders, the bishop has the "fullness of the priesthood". That is why, I, as a priest, share in the ministry of the bishop. I exercise some of his ministry in communion with him.

Adolescents may wonder how the *Gifts of the Holy Spirit* are to be lived in their lives. Isn't adolescence a time of life when a little craziness is expected? Well, we know young people are

still growing, especially their brains. The Holy Spirit takes us seriously and there are important ways of living the Gifts during adolescence that are both fun and sensible.

Finding the path to maturity should leave those around us better for our time with them. How do we deal with negative feelings and experiences? We do not want to take it out on others but come to grips honestly with our challenges. That effort will inspire others. When we are young we naturally want to use our strengths and talents. That's part of growing. Knowing that we are a full human person and that there are "tender spots" in us helps us to be patient with others ... including our parents!

And those of us who celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation long ago should be happy that the *Gifts of the Holy Spirit* have equipped us to reach out across generations and cultures. We can do so much to strengthen the bond of communion in Jesus Christ.

As we approach the coming Feast of Pentecost, let us pray together:

Come, Holy Spirit!
Renew us, fill our hearts,
Breathe into us the fire of Your love,
Inspire us with Your Gifts that the world of our daily lives,
and the wider world may be made new!
Amen!

May 27th & 28th, 2023




