Celebration of the Solemnity of St. Michael & Conferral of the Pallium upon the Most Rev. Francis Leo

Friday, September 29, 2023 – 5:30 pm – St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica - 65 Bond St.



On September 29th at 5:30 pm, in celebration of the Archdiocese of Toronto's patron, St. Michael's feast day, Archbishop Francis Leo will celebrate Mass at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica, including music from the world-renowned St. Michael's Choir School. As part of the celebration, the Apostolic Nuncio to Canada, the Most Rev. Ivan Jurkovič, will confer the pallium on our archbishop, a symbol of his role as Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto and shepherd to the faithful. Following Mass, there will be an informal reception with light refreshments in the St. Michael's Cathedral atrium and courtyard. Seating will be first come, first served. All are welcome to join in this special celebration for our archdiocese and archbishop! ***Due to the timing of this Mass, our parish Mass on September 29th will take place at 12:15 pm rather than the usual 5 pm.***

The 109th World Day of Migrants and Refugees ('WDoMaR')

Sunday, September 24, 2023

His Holiness Pope Francis announced this year's WDoMaR theme as "Free to Choose Whether to Migrate or to Stay." Pope Francis acknowledges that while the decision to migrate should always be free, in many cases it is not. This point was reflected by St. John Paul II in his 90th WDoMaR message in which he wrote, "building conditions of peace means in practice being seriously committed to safeguarding first of all the right not to emigrate, that is, the right to live in peace and dignity in one's own country." Pope Francis quoted the words of the Lord, "...I was a stranger, and you welcomed me" reminding us that the Lord's words are a "constant admonition to see in the migrant not simply a brother or sister in difficulty, but Christ himself, who knocks at our door."
