Many things have taken place over the past year, here at St. Paul's, that we can be thankful to the Holy Spirit for. It was about a year ago that I started meeting with people interested in becoming Catholic and it is just about a year ago that we welcomed Micah as our Youth Minister. Our already committed staff team of Lynett Wilson, Ives Alvarez and Jason Lo had laid a foundation for these outward looking activities.

In the fall we began with the Alpha program and out of that has sprung our Little Saints and Children's Choir. The adults who gathered around this faith-deepening program have developed into a community adding confidence to one another in looking forward to more. These gatherings after the 11am Mass continue to happen and have been responsible for our recent breakfasts. The "Edge" program began after Christmas and has formed into a nicely sized group, some of whom will participate in a summer camp north of the city this year. We have our own day camp for school-age kids, grades 1 to 7 as well.

We baptized four adults and received one into the Catholic Church at Easter. We have one more scheduled now for mid-

St. Paul's is running a three-week summer day camp for children in grades 1 to 7. The camp focuses on helping children learn about our Catholic faith while providing fun opportunities to meet new friends and participate in a variety of activities including games, arts & crafts and sports.
