# **\*** A Message from the Pastor

### The Eucharist, Our Foretaste of the Reign of God

At every celebration of the Mass we repeat the words of Christ. No matter which Eucharistic Prayer is used, these words are always present; "Take and eat, this is My Body". We refer to this as the "Paschal Mystery", when Jesus gives Himself to us as He did at the Last Supper and in His death and resurrection. Those two events are part of the Passover, which makes the New Covenant present.

What should our response be? Should we make a tent for Jesus, Moses and Elijah, as St. Peter wanted to do on the Mount of the Transfiguration? In a way, the image is a beautiful one: a home for Moses, Elijah and for Jesus, that they might abide together. However, in reality, our only possible response is gratitude, praise and thanksgiving followed by allowing ourselves to be present with Him. Peter's response was given out of nervousness; he wanted to do something!

Another scene we can meditate on is Jesus' appearance to the disciples when He breathes His Spirit upon them and utters the word, "Peace". We can strive to be at peace enough to abide in Christ. That's what we have the chance to do every time we celebrate Mass and especially when we receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

The Church calls the Eucharist "the source," and also the highest point of our life on earth. There is nothing in us, or about us, that is not brought to Christ as we come and share our thanks. We even call the Mass, "a sacrifice of praise" – a gift of ourselves. The Eucharist absorbs, in the redeeming love of Christ, our entire lives, and the breath of Christ's spirit sends us outward to share love made new and whole, whose very heart is divine and personal. "You have redeemed us, O Lord, in Your own Blood". This solemnity gives us the chance to be taken up anew in the life we received at our baptism.
