A Message from the Pastor

Journeying to the Manger

This weekend our Archbishop will be made a member of the College of Cardinals. The ceremony takes place on Saturday, and a few hours before we celebrate our first Mass this Sunday, a Mass will be celebrated with all the Cardinals present in Rome. The Holy Father will celebrate the Mass for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. For us, that feast has been transferred to Monday.

At the formal investiture on Saturday Cardinal Leo will learn of his "titular" church. He will become an honorary pastor of a parish in Rome. Cardinal Leo has a particular closeness to Our Lady. His appointment was announced on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and his installation as Archbishop occured on the Solemnity of the Annunciation. As Cardinal, he will celebrate his first Mass, along with the Holy Father, on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

On December 12th we also have the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, who is patronness of the Americas. On this feast day our Canadian bishops have invited all of us to pray for healing and reconciliation with our First Nations peoples. With these feasts of Our Lady, we celebrate the way in which God's grace acted in her, and through her, for the

benefit of us all. In her example we see her listen, pray, sometimes act and often be with others, especially be with her Son. In the work of healing and deepening relationships all these things are needed in the right measure, at the right time, with sensitive engagement, with love and respect. As we welcome Jesus anew into our consciousness, let us allow Him to shape us and guide us with the example of Mary.

In spousal relationships there are times to communicate abundantly with words and other times to do so with actions or even with quietly allowing one another some space. In what will surely be a long journey of reconciliation with our indigenous peoples may the gift of Jesus bring peace to them this year, and help us to be ready to learn and to support the work of the Holy Spirit in renewing the life of our diverse First Nations.

In the next few weeks, as we approach the Manger, may we also be renewed and discover the richness of our life in Christ more and more deeply. Whether we are young and building our lives, in the middle years striving to be of service in Christ, or older seeking to be united more intimately with Christ, this is a blessed time.

New to our St. Paul's Community?

Welcome to St. Paul's Basilica! If you've recently, or not so recently, joined our parish community, please take a moment to fill out a parish registration form. There are many benefits to registering at the parish. It enables easier and more accurate donation tracking so you receive a tax receipt. It allows us to verify your information if you need a reference or are planning to celebrate or be part of a sacrament in the future. We can even transfer your records to another parish if you move. Forms are available at the back of the church or in the parish office.

Moving / Moved?

If your mailing address has changed we kindly ask that you notify the parish office by phone at 416-364-7588 or email at stpaulsbasilica@archtoronto.org, so we can ensure our records are up-to-date and there are no delays in issuing tax receipts.

Different Ways to Give

There are many different ways to donate to the parish.

- Envelopes: If you use the visitor's envelopes and wish to receive a tax receipt, please ensure that your name and address are clearly written. Registered parishioners can request envelopes with assigned donor numbers linked to their records.
- 2. *Direct Debit:* You can sign up to have your donation debited monthly directly from your bank account or credit card. You can choose where to direct your donation within the parish or request an additional amount be debited for months with special archdiocesan collections.
- 3. *Securities:* By donating stocks, bonds or mutual funds you can avoid capital gains allowing you to give more.
- 4. *Time & Talent:* Donations don't always have to be monetary. Consider volunteering your time or abilities with a parish ministry or event.



Registration for Sacramental Preparation Now Open


