## \* A Message from the Pastor

#### **Sacred Persons**

90 - 4

Today's readings speak about sacred encounters with God. Isaiah hears the Lord addressing him, asking whom He should send, and Isaiah answers, "Send me." St. Paul gives us a litany of encounters with Christ, putting himself at the end of the list, as he describes the heart of our hope, Christ's resurrection. In the Gospel we hear the call of St. Peter, whose words seem to nearly echo of Isaiah, declaring that he is a sinful man and confused by the Lord's desire that Peter go with Him.

In my own life, these moments of encounter have also come unexpectedly. I think of the perceptive and caring responses of people at key moments in my life. I think of moments when I have rested in the Lord and suddenly found a new perspective. The encounters I seem to be most aware of are those where care and encouragement have been found.

This week we will have a rather secular celebration of love with a saint's name attached – Valentine. It is easy to advertise the pleasure of romantic love, but there is so much more to the love we want to give and to receive. As people whose lives are animated by Christ, we are infused with, and surrounded by Christ. Our mission in all our relationships is to recognize and engage with the all aspects of the other person, the person whom God loves and wishes to encounter, the other and ourselves.

It is hard to fully embrace all that we are, let alone show that to another person. We have all been blessed with the particular beauty of our love, our intellect, our emotions, our talents. It is an intricate dance between our openness and a healthy discipline that allows these things to come out in a way that is both integrated and fruitful for others. "Send me!"



No matter our circumstances this is a mission we all can embrace. Christ does encounter us in lots of ways; and sometimes we even notice it. Often, we don't realize that Christ is working through us, which is a good reason to invite Christ to guide us. As society slows down for a brief moment to give attention to romantic love, we should all take a moment to acknowledge love in its entirety.
